Isabel Moreno-Hay, DDS, PhD, ABOP - Orofacial Pain Clinic Director October 24, 2019 - "TMD"

Dr. Moreno Hay is currently an Assistant Professor in the Division of Orofacial Pain, University of Kentucky College of Dentistry. She is a graduate of the University Complutense of Madrid, School of Dentistry (Spain). In 2005, she completed a fellowship in implant prosthodontics at the University Complutense of Madrid. Dr. Moreno received a European Ph.D. degree in 2011 from University Complutense of Madrid. Her doctoral thesis on electromyography examined the electrical activity of masticatory muscles, stressing the role of electromyography in dentistry. Dr. Moreno graduated from the 2-year CODA approved program in Orofacial Pain at the University of Kentucky in 2013. She became a Diplomate of the American Board of Orofacial Pain in 2015. She is member of the American Academy of Orofacial Pain, Spanish Academy of Temporomandibular Disorders, American Academy of Sleep Medicine and Kentucky Sleep Medicine. She has published several research articles in international journals. She has presented in several international and regional courses on orofacial pain, temporomandibular disorders and sleep related breathing disorders. Her current areas of interest are orofacial pain and oral appliance therapy in sleep related breathing disorders.
